

Beaufort County Community College ID Card Procedures

All faculty, staff, and students at Beaufort County Community College will receive their first ID card free of charge. Replacements or additional cards are available for purchase at a cost of \$5.00, which must be paid at the cashier's office, upstairs in the Administration Building.

Please follow the following guidelines during issuance:

Student ID Cards:

- All students are required to present a current BCCC schedule with their student ID number or any official BCCC paperwork confirming that they are a currently enrolled student (i.e. tuition or registration receipt, current schedule, current transcript, screen shot of current self-service).
- The ID card will display first and last names only. Nicknames or abbreviations are unacceptable.
- The ID card will also display all seven (7) numbers of the student ID number. If only six (6) numbers are displayed, place a "0" at the beginning.
- Make sure students do not need a special program listed on the ID card. The Cosmetology Department requires different titles, per the State of NC. At this time, the only special programs are:
 - Advanced Cosmetology
 - Beginner Cosmetology
 - Nail Tech
 - Early College High School
