Beaufort Promise Scholarship

The Beaufort Promise Scholarship is a “last-dollar” scholarship program, which means that after the College expends all federal and state financial aid for which a student is eligible, Beaufort Promise will cover the remaining tuition and fees for a maximum of six consecutive semesters for credit programs or three consecutive semesters for non-credit programs. The College will not cover summer session tuition and fees through Beaufort Promise.

Beaufort County will cover Beaufort Promise Scholarships for Beaufort County residents who are United States citizens through at least May 2026. The College Foundation or other sources will cover Beaufort Promise Scholarships for students who are residents of Hyde, Tyrrell, and Washington Counties and, to the extent possible, non-citizens who are residents of Beaufort County.
