College Transfer Pathway

Associate in Arts Pathway (AA)

Associate in Science Pathway (AS)

To be fully qualified for College Transfer Pathways

Applicants must:

- Be a high school junior or senior. **AND**

Satisfy at least one of the following two options:

1. Have an unweighted High School GPA of 2.8 or higher.
2. Have qualifying test scores (see below).

High school students who do not meet the above criteria are not eligible to participate in the AA or AS pathway. High school principals cannot submit a waiver for students to enter an AA or AS pathway.

- The high School counselor will verify applicants have met the above qualifications and mark applicant as College Transfer Pathway eligible on CCP application.
- Applicants must complete a CCP BCCC application. Applicants will choose either: AA or AS. (Please note that it is more difficult for students to receive AS due to the additional science and math courses that are required.)

Career Technical Pathways

Career Technical Education Pathway (Juniors and Seniors)

- Be a high school junior or senior **AND**

Satisfy at least one of the following three options:

1. Have an unweighted high school GPA of 2.8 or higher.
2. Have a recommended **GPA waiver** from the high school principal or his / her designee and approval of the BCCC Chief Academic Officer. The high school principal must submit a rationale for the waiver.
3. Have qualifying test scores (see below).

The following restrictions apply:

- The high school counselor will verify applicants have met the above qualifications and mark applicant as CTE eligible on the CCP BCCC application.
- Applicants will complete a CCP BCCC application indicating they are entering as CCP CTE student.
- Applicants who qualify through a waiver by the principal or designee are not allowed to enter a CTE pathway containing any UGETC courses.

Career Technical Education Pathway (Freshmen and Sophomores)

- High school freshmen and sophomores may only enter pathways in Engineering, Industrial, or Agricultural. Pathways selected cannot contain any UGETC courses.

Applicants must:

- Have the recommendation of the high school principal or his/her designee and approval of the BCCC Chief Academic Officer. **AND**

Satisfy at least one of the following two options:

1. Received a grade of C or higher in Math 1 and a score of 3 or higher on the Math 1 EOC and a score of 3 or higher on the 8th grade ELA assessment.
2. Have qualifying test scores (see below).
