How to Qualify for Lifeline

You may be eligible to receive free government phone service, plus a free phone if you participate in the following government programs:

Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) (Food Stamps)

Medicaid

Supplemental Security Income (SSI)

Federal Public Housing Assistance (FPHA)

Veterans Pension or Survivors Benefit Programs

Tribal Specific Programs

- o Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) General Assistance
- Tribal Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (Tribal TANF)
- o Food Distribution Program on Indian Reserves (FDPIR)
- Tribal Head Start Income Eligibility

You may also qualify based on your household income. You must provide proof of program participation or proof of income.

Don't enjoy setting at the doctor's office? Then learn about Telehealth! Your Digital Navigator will be happy to help you get started!


Telehealth is an important tool in providing access to health care for all North Carolinians.
