- A. Completing the courses above (1<sup>st</sup> year) will meet all of the general education requirements for the A.D.N. program. While it is not required, it is **highly recommended** for students to complete these courses before applying to the A.D.N. program because they provide a foundation of knowledge needed for the NUR courses. Furthermore, these courses are used in determining a student's program G.P.A. and quality points for A.D.N. program admission. It is recommended that students strive for a program G.P.A. of greater than 3.3 to have a competitive application for ranking. The A.D.N. program accepts 60 students each fall. There is an average of 100+ applications submitted each year. (**See the A.D.N. point calculation sheet.**)
- *Program G.P.A. is based solely on the general education courses affiliated with the A.D.N. program (1<sup>st</sup> year courses above). Therefore, a grade in a welding, cosmetology, etc. course will not be used to calculate A.D.N. program G.P.A.*
- B. The courses listed below are courses that fulfill B.S.N. general education requirements. The courses are based on the 5-block articulation agreement for A.D.N. to B.S.N. degrees. If a student misses the application deadline for A.D.N. admission, or if a student was not chosen for acceptance into the A.D.N. program, they may take the courses below (2<sup>nd</sup> year) while they are waiting to reapply to the nursing program. The courses below may be used in point calculations **only if** the student has completed all of the courses associated in the first year. Also, a student that is accepted to the A.D.N. program may take the courses below, while taking the specified A.D.N. program courses. This allows students to continue working toward B.S.N. pre-requisite completion while being concurrently enrolled in the A.D.N. program.
